STUDENT EMERGENCY KIT

Dear Parents,

Before school starts you will need to create your child's emergency pack that we will keep on hand in case students must remain at school for a prolonged period of time. - 1 pocket size pack of tissues
- 2 granola bars or similar snack
- 4 candy suckers
- ♦ 1 packaged emergency blanket, approx. 53"x82", in the camping supply section

Please be sure to attach a family photo to the emergency information card, this photo will assist us in releasing your child to you after an emergency if he/she is with a staff member who does not know your family.

Please note: We must have an emergency kit for <u>every</u> child. Please don't assume that supplies sent by others will support your child. Please limit the items you send to only the items/quantities listed above.
